

Call Forward Don't Answer with Ring Control

When you can't answer your phone, Call Forwarding - Don't Answer with Ring Control sends the call to another number.

First, decide where you'd like your calls to go, perhaps to your voice mail or answering service.

Your line automatically forwards calls after 4 rings. With Ring Control, you can program the number of times the phone should ring before being forwarded (between 2 and 9).

Changing the Number of Rings

1. At the dial tone, dial * **4 7** ¹
2. At the second dial tone, dial the number of rings.
(For example, to have your calls forwarded after about 5 rings, dial **5**.)
3. Hang up after you hear the short tones followed by dial tone.
The number of rings has been changed.

Please Note

- If you subscribe to Call Waiting, changing the number of rings also changes the length of time before a waiting call is forwarded.
- Your caller may hear an extra ring due to connection timing.
